
Larger screens are shipped with slot nuts, bolts, and vertical support bars. These must be installed on large, split frame screens, or wall brackets must be installed top and bottom.













Install the t-slot nuts in the horizontal frame pieces before the brackets.




















Starting from the upper-left corner, attach the snap attachments, working around the ends on all four sides of the screen material.








Acoustically Transparent (AT) materials come with a black backer that must be installed to eliminate shine through.



Unroll the black backer material over the screen material. Hook the S hooks into the channel in the frame and then attach to the holes in the black backer material.











Maestro material has a black backer that must be installed with the viewing material to eliminate shine through.





Starting in the middle of each horizontal and vertical, snap/bungee the middle of each side, then work your way outward, completing a side at a time.








Maestro Screen Flattening

- Detach the bungees from the vertical/horizontal posts beside the wrinkles.
- Start from the middle post of the vertical/horizontal frame and pull outward, gripping the material tightly along the rod until all wrinkles are gone.
- Correct all sides from the middle working out to the corners.
- Reattach bungees to secure the material once it is flattened.
